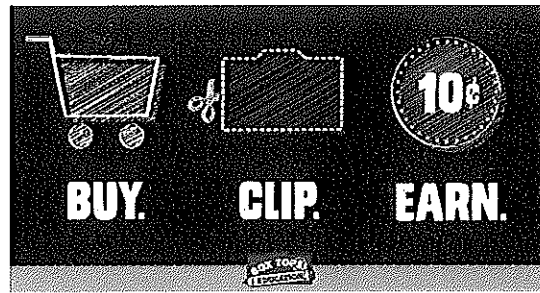
## Important Announcement about the FLU SEASON

Flu season is here. The influenza (Flu) virus spreads from person to person, mostly from coughs and sneezes of sick people. The virus can also spread by sharing objects (drinks, eating utensils) or close contact (shaking hands, kissing) with an infected person. Symptoms of the flu include: fever, cough, sore throat, runny nose, headache, body aches, fatigue, nausea/vomiting, diarrhea, and lack of appetite.

### Guidelines for the flu:

- Keep children who feel ill or have a fever of 100° F or greater at home and consult your family physician. *Important:* Your child's temperature should be under 99° F without fever reducing medications for 24 hours prior to returning to school. Your child should also be free from vomiting/diarrhea for 24 hours prior to returning to school. Health is more important than perfect attendance.
- When your child is well enough to return to school, send a note with your child on the day he/she returns to school, stating the specific reason for the absence.

The school staff is **NOT** allowed to give medication at school, even over-the-counter medications such as non-aspirin, cough syrup, etc., without written authorization from a physician.

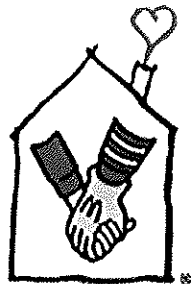
We need 400 people to attend this event to break the record. All students, families and friends are invited to participate in this world record breaking event.
